

HOW MANY MORE PEOPLE MUST DIE?

The “How Many More People Must Die?” Memorial will be unveiled upon the anniversary of the shelling of Kramatorsk, as a reminder of those killed in Eastern Ukraine.

On 10 February, non-governmental organizations operating in Eastern Ukraine will unveil the “How Many More People Must Die?” Memorial in Kramatorsk.

On this day - 10 February 2015, the airport and residential districts of Kramatorsk were shelled by rockets. According to the UN, the number of deaths as a result of the war that was started in 2014 in Eastern Ukraine by the Russian Federation has exceeded 10,000 people.

The unveiling of the Memorial will be held with the participation of the NGOs Information Security, Donetsk Institute of Information, Anti-Crisis Media Centre, DII Kramatorsk Centre, Vostok-SOS, and other NGO representatives, as well as of the authorities of the city of Kramatorsk.

The event is scheduled on February 10th, at 13:00.
